

SAFETY TIPS:

Please do not linger on the runway when picking up your airplane. It 1. is important that you vacate the runway as quickly as possible as long as its safe to move your airplane.

- Do not park your airplane on the main taxiway, as it makes it difficult 2. for pilots to taxi out to the runway and to taxi back after landing. Many parked planes have been struck on the taxiway. Be smart, park elsewhere.
- When crossing the runway, please make sure that you get 3. acknowledgement from all active pilots (in the pilots' box) that it is ok to cross the runway. Do not walk diagonally across the runway; always cross perpendicular to the runway for safety.








IMPORTANT CLUB NEWS

The Parks Department has been monitoring the lake for hazardous conditions and previously closed the lake. As of 30 May 2017, "LAKE FLYING" is <u>re-opened</u> until further notice. Please check our website for any new closures. Lake flying must be in accordance with PBRCA Safety Rules



The membership has approved the proposed rules for flying off 'West Lake'; at our May 9, 2016 membership meeting. The changes and additions are now incorporated into our Safety Rules as Revision K (rev.k).

Palm Beach County has previously established "flying" boundaries and we need to adhere to those restrictions. There is an aerial map showing the boundary lines for west & south flying and it is posted in the bulletin board located at the "impound". Our club has already been warned about flying over the Everglades by a Federal Wildlife Officer. You must fly within the designated boundaries!
