Palm Beach Radio Control Association Field Safety Rules

Last Modified: 5/10/2012

All Members and guests must follow the AMA Safety Code and as defined by the Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department.

In addition to the rules implied above, the following Club Safety Rules apply.

Section 1: General Rules.

1) Rule deleted.

2) Pilots MUST maintain a safe distance from spectators and other aircraft.

SAFETY TIPS:

1. Please do not linger on the runway when picking up your airplane. It is important that you vacate the runway as quickly as possible as long as its safe to move your airplane.
2. Do not park your airplane on the main taxiway, as it makes it difficult for pilots to taxi out to the runway and to taxi back after landing. Many parked planes have been struck on the taxiway. Be smart, park elsewhere.
3. When crossing the runway, please make sure that you get acknowledgement from all active pilots (in the pilots' box) that it is ok to cross the runway. Do not walk diagonally across the runway; always cross perpendicular to the runway for safety.

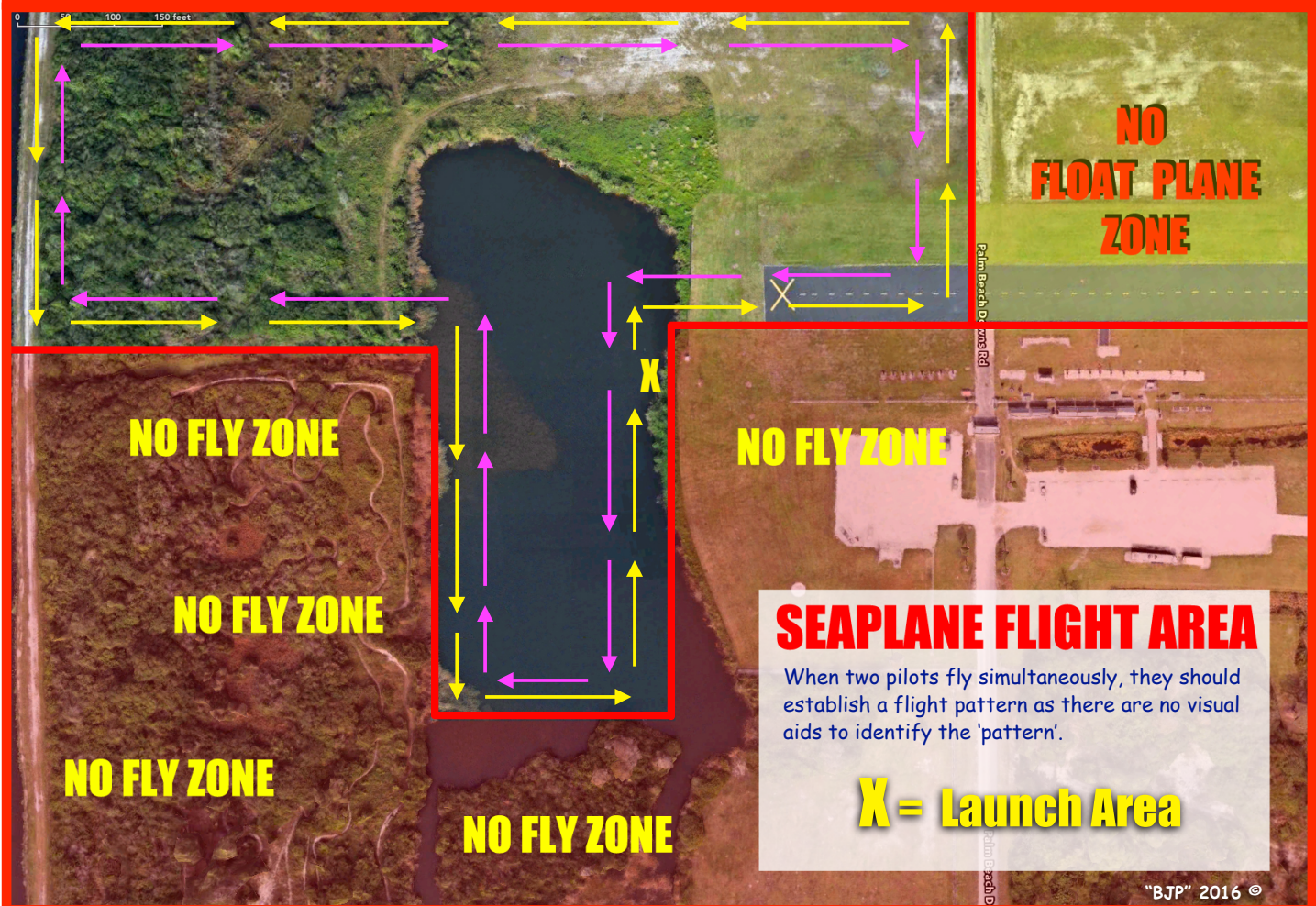

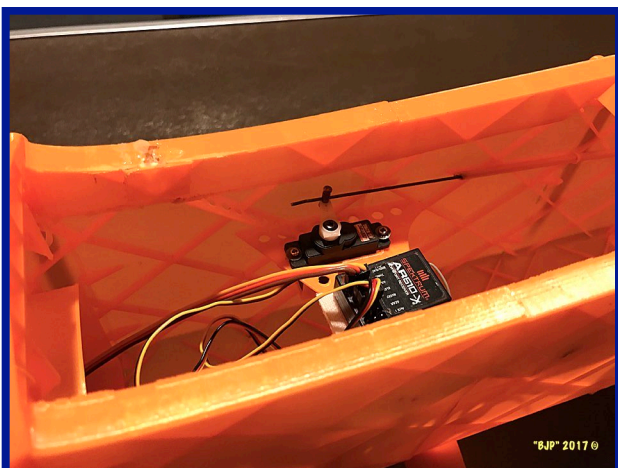
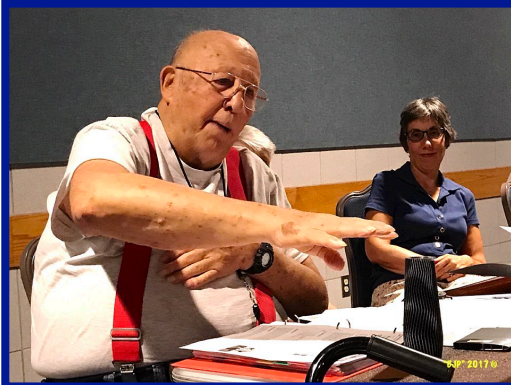
